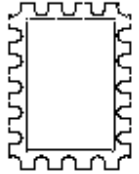

Who We Are The Isle of Standauffish is a Non-Profit Renaissance Re-Creation Guild made up of many separate and distinct groups dedicated to a common goal of historical education. We have created a working history for the group around the Tudor period starting with Henry VII to Henry VIII (late 15th c to early 16th c). This does not exclude the teaching of other time periods such as the Shakespearean theatre of early 17th century, or other periods and geographical areas.

Youth Education

One of the Primary goals of the guild is the promotion of the historical youth educational program through classes, workshops and events. We offer instruction in Sewing and Needle arts, Medieval Armouring and Blacksmithing, Court, Middle Eastern, and Folk Dance, Medieval and Renaissance Music, Woodworking and Leather Craft, Jewelry and Metal Smithing, Pottery and Ceramics, Period Style Cooking, Heraldry and Calligraphy, as well as historical re-enacting.

Shakespearean Theatre

Another popular program of the Isle of Standauffish is the Shakespearean Theatre Youth Guild. Students study the classics of William Shakespeare, and have the opportunity to make costumes, build props and stage sets, and perform at several events throughout the year.

Honor and Chivalry

Students and Adults learn the ideas of Honor and Chivalry as a basis for all activities in the Guild. Although not all Members or Students will achieve Knighthood, all are encouraged to carry these Knightly virtues into their mundane life to help create a better community.

From the Treasurer

Guild Directors are Knights of the Order of the Red Dragon and are expected to uphold a strict code of Honor and Chivalry in both public and corporate dealings. The Guild endeavors to use no more than 25% on administration and fund raising events so that the largest portion will benefit our youth education programs. Surplus proceeds go to a Scholarship Fund.
